# GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY **AND** ENJOYMENT

## **CONNECTING YOUR TV TO THE INTERNET**

To connect your TV to Tingo Internet, you'll need to enter its **Wi-Fi MAC address** using your phone or another internet-connected device.

Here's how:

**Step 1:** Find Your TV's MAC Address

Open your TV's Settings menu (usually via the remote).

Go to **Network or About** (this varies by brand).

Select Network Status or Network Information.

Look for the **Wi-Fi MAC Address** — it will look like this: **(00:1A:2B:3C:4D:5E)**

**Step 2:** Enter the MAC Address on Your Phone

Connect your phone to Tingo Internet.

A page will open prompting you to register your device.

Select the option to add another device.

**Enter the TV's MAC address exactly as shown.**

Once registered, your TV should be able to connect!

## **FACILITIES**

Avila Pismo RV Resort is a privately owned campground for registered guests only. Use facilities at your own risk; the park assumes no liability for accidents, injuries, or property damage. We reserve the right to refuse or discontinue service, change site numbers, and adjust prices and policies without refund.

## **GUESTS**

Reservations cover up to 2 adults per campsite. Additional guests incur a fee. Max 6 people per RV site, 2-4 for cabins. No guest vehicles can be parked on site. Visitors must check in at office. No visitors after 10:00 PM.

## **PARKING**

**Only one RV and towing vehicle allowed per site.** All vehicles must park within the site boundaries, not in roadways or empty sites.

## **CAMPSITES**

**No charging of electric vehicles.** No washing vehicles or RVs, oil changes, or major mechanical work allowed. Only licensed mechanics may perform repairs. No generators, fireworks, or firearms. Do not walk or drive through campsites. BBQs must not be placed on picnic tables. Damage will incur replacement/repair charges.

## **CHILDREN**

**No bikes, skateboards, rollerblades, or scooters after dark. Helmets recommended. Children 14 and under must be supervised by an adult at all times, including in the game room and pool. \*\*5 MPH for all recreational equipment and bikes!\*\***

## **POOL**

**Pool and hot tub hours: 10:00 AM - 9:00 PM.** For registered guests only. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult. No pets, bikes, or glass in the pool area.

## **TENTS**

**No tents on RV or cabin sites.** Do not hang clotheslines, towels, or hammocks from RVs, trees, or fences.

## **FIRE**

**No Smoking of any kind allowed on property.** Only propane and charcoal briquettes allowed for campfires. No wood, wood chips, or smokers.

## **SEWER**

A screw-in connection is required for the sewer. Only septic-safe toilet paper may be flushed. Do not flush wipes, diapers, sanitary items, or use formaldehyde products.

## **FLAGS**

Only the traditional American Flag may be displayed.

## **SPEED LIMIT**

**5 MPH max** for all vehicles. Please drive cautiously—kids, pets, and bikes can be hard to see.

## **QUIET HOURS**

**10:00 PM - 8:00 AM.** Keep noise to a minimum, and do not use the playground after dusk. Generators are not permitted.

## **OBJECTIONABLE BEHAVIOR**

We have a zero-tolerance policy for abusive behavior, language, or rudeness. Violators will be asked to leave without a refund.

## **PETS**

We welcome pets, but aggressive breeds are not allowed. Keep pets on a leash, quiet, and never unattended. **Pick up after your pet using provided bags. Pets are not allowed in buildings, the playground, or the pool area.** An off-leash dog park is available. Pet-friendly cabins are also available.



## **PATIO SITES:**

- For your safety, and the integrity of our equipment, please do not move any patio furniture, firepits, grills, or propane tanks from your site. Doing so may incur in a repair/replacement fee
- To maintain the integrity of our sites, tents are not permitted on RV sites.
- One vehicle is allowed per site at a time.
- Enjoy one free propane refill per day for your firepit or grill during office hours. If you need extra propane outside of this, we'll be happy to provide it for an additional charge.

## **CABINS:**

### **Check-Out Instructions:**

- Please remember to remove any trash from the cabin before departure. You'll find 4 convenient dumpsters around the property for disposal.
- If you've used any dishes, kindly give them a quick wash and return them to their proper place.
- The cabin should be left the way it was found.

### **Additional Information:**

- For Cabins 1-9, there's a switch in the kitchen that controls the water heater. Please make sure the switch is on upon arrival, and feel free to leave it on for the duration of your stay.
- Keep in mind, the water heaters are on the smaller side, so they may need a few minutes to reheat between uses.

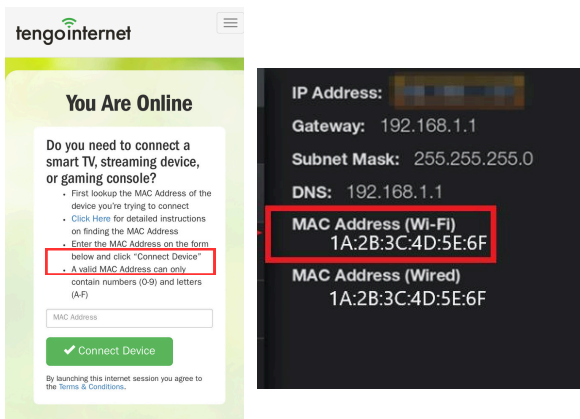
